UT Arlington faculty and students are invited to participate in the InnovationDay@UTA with a poster presentation highlighting the research being conducted by our University inventors.

POSTER PRESENTATION SUBMISSION AND DEADLINES

Poster presentations provide a perfect opportunity to elaborate on research and information without the time constraints typically allotted oral presentations.

Poster presenters are required to register for the symposium and indicate their participation as a poster presenter no later than Friday, October 2, 2015. Register at <u>cvent.com</u>.

Poster presenters are required to send UT Arlington an electronic preview of your poster no later than Friday, October 9, 2015 to innovationday@uta.edu. Please use the subject line: Innovation Day@UTA Poster Presentation

Poster presenters are responsible for the printing and delivery of the posters and all associated costs. A list of local printers can be found at the end of this document.

FORMATTING GUIDELINES

In order to provide a visual presentation that will connect with the viewer please adhere to the following formatting guidelines:

- Posters are required to be: 36" x 48" and mounted to a foam board.
- PowerPoint templates are available for creating a poster if you use their custom size option in the "page setup" found in the Design tab.
- Background should be light colored and text should be black or dark font.
- Convert word tables, and excel spreadsheets to images before adding them to your PowerPoint slides so that when they are enlarged they will print correctly.
- It is the responsibility of the presenter to use images that are in the public domain unless you have satisfied copyright or other use restrictions.
- Please deliver posters to the conference registration desk at College Park Center by 8:00 AM on Thursday, October 22, 2015.





You are welcome to stay near the poster area during conference breaks and during the reception on Thursday, October 22 from 5:00-6:30 PM in order to interact one-one-one with attendees interested in your research.

- Presenters should plan on retrieving their posters at the conclusion of the conference.

 - o Organization
 - o Introduction
 - o Abstract
 - o Bulleted points with main subject areas
 - Methodologies
 - o Tables/Graphs/Charts/Images
 - o Conclusions/Results
 - o References
 - o Further Research Questions
