Advanced Road Inspector Course Prerequisites

- **OSHA #510 - Occupational Safety and Health Standards for the Construction Industry** - This course covers OSHA Standards, policies, and procedures in the construction industry. Topics include scope and application of the OSHA Construction Standards, construction safety and health principles, and special emphasis on those areas in construction which are most hazardous. Upon course completion students will have the ability to define construction terms found in the OSHA Construction Standards, identify hazards which occur in the construction industry, locate, and determine appropriate OSHA Construction Standards, policies, and procedures, and describe the use of the OSHA Construction Standards and regulations to supplement an ongoing safety and health program.
- **WKZ520 - Work Zone Traffic Control and Qualified Flagger** - This is the primary course for all personnel involved in the design, layout, and maintenance of traffic control devices on public roadways. Participants who complete this course will receive a qualified Flagger card good for four years.
- **WTR302 - Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plans** - This course will teach participants how to manage the complexities of storm water management and relate regulatory requirements to ensure compliance to federal, state and local laws. The focus of the course is to offer practical solutions to factors that contribute to pollution of our nation's waters. In addition to presentations of subject matter, students are assigned case studies, reading material and quizzes designed to build knowledge, skills and abilities in this vital field.
